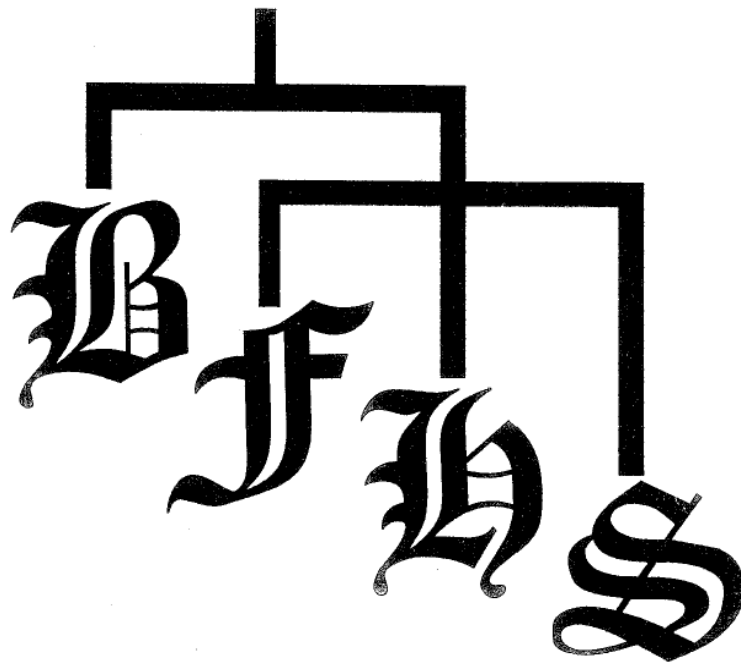

Marriage Licences for Bedfordshire - Download of Database

The BFHS marriage licence database provides information for the years 1578-1618, 1747-1790 and 1791-1812. The entries within the database are sorted alphabetically by surname and then forename. Entries recorded provide details of occupations, previous marital status, abode, age, date of licence, along with details of whom they are to marry. Entries are also recorded within the database to provide information about who is providing surety for the licence.

RESEARCH SERVICE

Our research service is available to Society members. It is intended to concentrate on sources within Bedfordshire, although it may be possible if initial enquiries lead outside of the borders, for the leads to be pursued by agreement. Contact can be by email or by letter to the Society Researcher at the PO Box address. Our charges are £10 per hour with a minimum charge of £5 plus the cost of any photocopies and postage. Please be aware that both negative and positive results will be charged for. Payments must be made in Sterling (by cheque or bankers draft) payable to Bedfordshire Family History Society. Payments may also be made via the Parish Chest and GenFair websites (follow the link from our website) by purchasing units worth £10.

The required research should be specified as precisely as possible stating what you want to find out and giving detailed information on what you know and which sources have already been checked. It is helpful to specify an initial limit to research expenditure, although this can be discussed further once initial results have been ascertained. For research that will take more than one hour we offer a free initial half hour to ascertain that the research will be worth undertaking and to help to define scope and likely cost.

We do not undertake research for whole family trees nor for living relatives. We reserve the right to refuse lengthy or complicated research for which we may refer you to a professional researcher. It may be possible to undertake research for non-members, but only at the discretion of the researcher and if no research for members is currently outstanding.

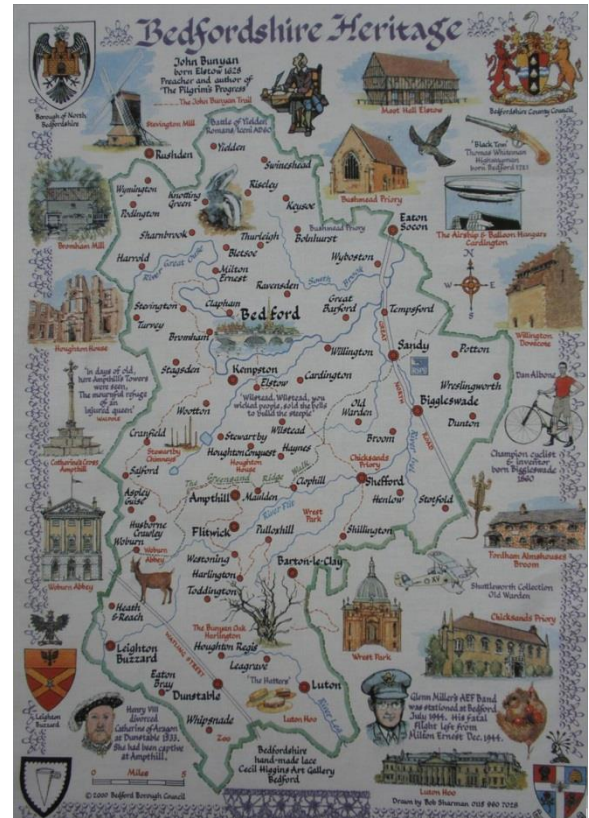
BEDFORDSHIRE HERITAGE TEA TOWELS

GENERAL NOTE ON THE SUPPLY OF ALL MICROFICHE PRODUCED BY BFHS:

In recent years sales volumes have been very low and no longer justify keeping and listing the stock. The Society is therefore no longer able to offer microfiche for sale.

The Society has converted the content of the microfiche to digital files that can be read and searched on a PC. These files are available through our published Parish Records series, either as CDs or digital downloads.
